Youth 9th—12th grade meets at Impact House each Wed. at 6:30 pm for time of fellowship & devotion.



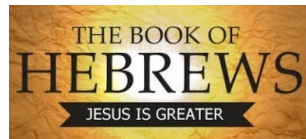
WOM meets on the first Sunday of each month at 4:50 pm for fellowship & mission projects. ALL ladies are encouraged to attend.

Why Churches Have Crop Failures
Mark 4:1-9; Vv. 14-20

I. Introduction: Crop failures have always been common to farmers due to many factors.

II. In our text, where does the failure take place? It is a failure of:

- A. The Sower? The preacher/teacher?
- B. The Seed? The Word?

Since we have ruled out the first two, we are left with the Soil. This parable list three reasons the soil is the problem.

III. These three are:

- A. The Hard heart. V. 15
- B. The Shallow heart. Vv. 16-17
- C. The Crowded heart. Vv. 18-19
- D. The good soil of the Fruitful heart. V. 20

Conclusion: What kind of soil are you?
