The Lottie Moon Week of Prayer and Offering: I saw a great multitude from every nation and all tribes. Rev. 7:9. The SBC's efforts to reach the nations include supporting 3,692 international missionaries. They engaged 847 people groups last year. From that work, there were 77,605 new believers, 18,428 new pastors trained, and 13,898 new churches planted. There are still 7,089 unreached people groups and 3,176 unengaged, unreached people groups.

DFBC's goal for international missions is \$5,650. The national goal is \$165 million. On Dec. 1st, the bulletins will contain a prayer guide.
